





Total number of physical and electronic items in the Library's Collection



The Leach Public Library continues to be a vital source for the citizens of Wahpeton and Richland County to connect with over 89539 items to enrich, entertain and educate people of all ages.

In addition to the always popular traditional book collections, the library also offers audiobooks, movies, music, e-books, STEM kits, and programming for all ages.

### **Fun Library Trivia**

The Library's 2023 Summer Reading Program saw 113 patrons registered, who read a total of 2160 days. The most popular in-person program the Library held was the Haunted Library-we had over 70 participants. The Library has 28 Outreach programs, reaching 1134 citizens.

In 2023, we updated our public access computers, did a re-hab of our Young Adult area, and had some outdoor masonry repair completed.
